A candidate may submit an optional candidacy statement limited to one page and no more than 250 words in 11-point font. Words exceeding the 250-word limit will not be published. Handwritten statements will not be retyped. Statements will be distributed without editing, except for enforcement of the stated page and word limits. The candidate, not the Association, is responsible for the statement's content.

Suggested topics:

- Why you would like to serve on the Board.
- Your background and experience.
- Your vision for the community and what you would like to accomplish if elected.

DEADLINE: Candidate Nomination Forms and optional candidacy statements must be received by 10:00 a.m. on August 25, 2026. Late submissions will not be accepted.

Candidate Qualifications

Under the Association's Election Rules, a candidate must be a member of La Jolla Alta Common Council No. 1 at the time of nomination. If title to a Unit is held by a legal entity rather than a natural person, the governing authority of that entity may appoint a natural person to be a member for purposes of nomination to the Board.

A nominee is not qualified if the nominee is ninety (90) days or more delinquent in the payment of regular or special assessments. This does not include fines, fines renamed as assessments, collection charges, late charges, or costs levied by a third party.

A nominee will not be disqualified if the applicable assessment has been paid under protest pursuant to Civil Code section 5658 or the nominee has entered into a payment plan pursuant to Civil Code section 5665.

Before disqualifying a nominee, the Association will offer the nominee an opportunity to participate in Internal Dispute Resolution pursuant to Civil Code section 5900 et seq.
